CHAMPAGNE

The Champagne region is a strictly defined area of France, encompassing 634 villages in five different departments: the Aisne, Aube, Haute-Marne, Marne and Seine-et-Marne. However, the viticulture appellation is even more restricted, and only 318 of these villages have the right to produce the wine called Champagne. Champagne, the wine, can only come from Champagne, the region, and in the European Union, as well as in those countries who have agreed to reciprocal arrangements with the E.U., the use of the word Champagne to refer to any other products is strictly forbidden.

GRAPPA

Grappa is an alcoholic beverage, a fragrant, grape-based pomace brandy of Italian origin. There are four categories of grappa: young, cask-conditioned, aromatic and aromatized grappa's. Grappa tastings begin with young grappa's, then continue with cask-conditioned and aromatic grappa's and finish with aromatized grappa's.

BARRICCATA

Grappa that matures in wooden barrels, dark in color and with notes of sweet spices mix with the fruits. Vintage Grappa is very high quality.

COGNAC

Named after the town of Cognac in France, is a variety of brandy made from Ugni blanc. It is produced in the wine-growing region surrounding the town from which it takes its name, in the French Departments of Charente and Charente-Maritime. The region authorized to produce cognac is divided into six zones: Grande Champagne, Petite Champagne, Borderies, Fins Bois, Bon Bois and finally Bois Ordinaire. A blend of Grande and Petite Champagne Cognacs, with at least half coming from Grande Champagne, is known as Fine Champagne.
